If any parents/carers work in a career associated with STEM and would be willing to come in and meet with our pupils, please contact the School Office.





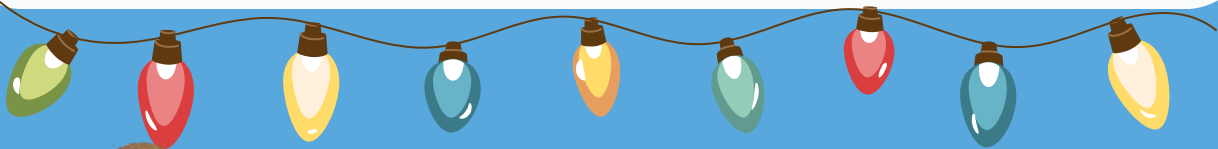
